Memorandum for Campbell County

January 4, 2021

SUBJECT: COVID-19 Vaccination Scheduling System

1. **PURPOSE:** Provide contact and scheduling information to Citizens.
2. **GENERAL:** The Tennessee Department of Health is implementing Covid-19 **vaccination AND testing**. As on January 1st, vaccines are available to designated healthcare workers and Citizens age 75 and over. While vaccine lots are in distribution channels, the scheduling system is slow and Citizens have not been able to get through. I am requesting of the Governor's Office to provide more telephone operators for the scheduling system.

As of today, all appointments for Campbell County are booked through tomorrow, Tuesday, January 5th. Vaccine shipments have not yet been confirmed, so Wednesday appointments for January 6th are not yet available. When the shipments are confirmed, appointment scheduling for Wednesday will begin again. I have asked for it to begin before close of business today, yet have no confirmation.

3. **PHONE NUMBER:** Citizens may use the vaccine hotline at **865-549-5343** to schedule. Vaccines are by appointment. Vaccination will be either drive up (staff comes to your car), or drive through (cars pull through tent for testing), based upon staff availability, weather and patient requirements.

4. **SCHEDULES:**

Monday-Wednesday-Friday: 9am-12pm (last appointment is 11:30am)

Tuesday-Thursday: 1pm-3pm (last appointment is 2:30pm)
